This highlights the importance of a robust global strategy, which serves as a vital link between the Misk Foundation, youth, Saudi Arabia, and international stakeholders. To achieve these goals, a range of Misk Global projects are implemented.

Misk Global Forum:

The Misk Global Forum is the flagship youth event of the Misk Foundation and one of the biggest youth platforms in the region. Launched in 2016, the Forum has hosted seven editions, featuring worldrenowned speakers and experts from around the globe. Each year, the event explores a theme that resonates with youth and reflects the key issues and contexts of the time.

Youth Majlis at Davos (World Economic Forum):

Misk Global amplifies the youth voice at the World Economic Forum in Davos by hosting the Youth Majlis, where young leaders engage in pivotal discussions with global decision-makers on issues that matter most to youth. Youth Majlis at Davos 2024 hosted 16 sessions on "Youth-Led Positive Social Impact," featuring 51 speakers from 22 countries and engaging 4,700 attendees.

Global Youth Series:

Through Misk Foundation's network and global citizenship programs, Saudi youth delegates are actively involved in key international youth initiatives led by organizations such as the World Economic Forum, UNESCO, and the UN. They participate as speakers in prominent global forums and events, including the ECOSOC Youth Forum (New York, USA), Y20 (Rio de Janeiro, Brazil), UNGA Summit (New York, USA), COP16 (Riyadh, KSA), and the World Economic Forum (Davos, Switzerland).

Research and Publications:

Misk Global is a knowledge hub for youth related topics. This includes multiple surveys and research papers that are published throughout the year. These include but are not limited to: Global Youth Index (GYI), Youth Majlis Insights report, MGF Outcome Report, Misk Global Survey.

































































AGREEMENTS

In a significant collaboration announced at the MGF 2024, the Misk Foundation and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation launched the **Challenge for Change** program, aimed at supporting nonprofits and social enterprises in Saudi Arabia. Building on the success of Misk's 2021 Youth Non-profit Organization Building Program, which helped launch 41 new organizations, the Challenge for Change program will offer up to \$2.5 million in grant funding to incubate Saudi-based initiatives focused on technological, environmental, and health solutions with both local and global impact.

Alongside the launch, the Gates Foundation revealed plans for a new regional office in Mohammed Bin Salman Nonprofit City "Misk City", reinforcing their \$600 million partnership with Saudi Arabia to advance global health, poverty reduction, and youth empowerment.

















Takeaways

- 2. Market research and consumer feedback are crucial in ensuring a solution is effective and accepted. Never fear starting over based on feedback. Collaboration and partnerships are also vital for innovation: engaging with diverse networks opens doors to valuable resources.
- 3. Failure is key to growth—embrace setbacks, learn, and adapt to market changes. It is also crucial to make use of mentorship to gain new perspectives, so seek guidance from experts, particularly in areas beyond your expertise.

GRASSROOTS OR INSTITUTIONAL CHANGE?



Synopsis:

What's the best path to sustainable development? This debate weighed grassroots community action against engagement with more established institutions to identify the most strategic path for youth-led change.

Takeaways

- Grassroots efforts often ignite awareness and drive rapid, communitybased actions, while institutional reforms provide the structural support and enforcement needed for lasting impact. However, grassroots movements often face resource limitations and minimal influence on policy, highlighting the need for institutional support.
- 2. Institutional reforms are crucial to turning grassroots awareness into systemic change, as seen in Greta Thunberg's climate advocacy and the Paris Agreement. In today's digital age, grassroots movements like Marcus Rashford's school meals campaign bypass bureaucratic barriers, pressuring institutions to act.
- 3. Effective societal transformation requires collaboration between grassroots initiatives and institutional systems, combining passion with scalability.

PARALLEL PATHS OR DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS?



Synopsis:

Fresh from a riveting discussion, this session dived into summarizing and synthesizing diverse perspectives, connecting ideas and insights from different contexts to provide a clear and cohesive understanding of the key takeaways.

- 1. Institutional reform must align with grassroots transformation for meaningful change, with trust-building key to collaboration.
- 2. A "translator" between institutions and grassroots efforts bridges understanding gaps, ensuring inclusive policies. Trust-building is especially challenging across generations, but local and national initiatives help create accountability and address youth issues.
- 3. Change requires collective action, with dialogue and inclusivity fostering a more effective approach to societal needs.

Water is life, and Laalitya Acharya is fighting to protect it. In this session, she shared how she is blending science, policy and innovation to ensure safe, clean water for future generations.

- 1. Technological solutions must tackle the root causes of contamination, as existing methods for detecting microbial contamination in water are expensive, inaccurate, and inaccessible. An affordable, practical solution is crucial.
- 2. Innovation must go hand-in-hand with policy. Effective science policy bridges research and real-world application, ensuring solutions are implemented.

CULTURE – REINTERPRETING HERITAGE FOR THE FUTURE

Empowering Youth for a Brighter Tomorrow

Align youth aspirations with Saudi Vision 2030, empowering them to lead cultural transformation and drive meaningful national growth. Saudi Vice Minister of Tourism, HH Princess Haifa Bint Mohammed Al Saud illustrated the transformative journey under Vision 2030, emphasizing adaptability and persistence. According to her, "flexibility is key to achieving what once seemed impossible—like integrating women into sports." Reflecting on her daughter's ambitions to be both a DJ and an astronaut, Princess Haifa concluded, "Saudi Arabia teaches our youth that nothing is impossible."

Unleashing Creative Forces

Unshackle the power of youth-driven creative industries – filmmaking, podcasting, anime, and more – to preserve traditions and expand cultural influence. Game producer Ohoud Alqahtani, and artist Mohammed Aldhafeeri, showcased the efforts of Manga Productions' team in putting Saudi Arabia on the global anime map. Mohammed stated, "Every episode of Future's Folktales involves deep cultural and historical research, ensuring authenticity while pushing creative boundaries." Ohoud added, "Through anime and gaming, we're not just creating entertainment but preserving and celebrating Saudi stories." Their discussion highlighted how youth creativity in anime and gaming transforms Saudi heritage into global cultural assets.

Building Stronger Communities

Foster community engagement by empowering youth to lead art, media, and storytelling initiatives, cultivating a strong sense of collective identity and belonging. During his fireside chat, HRH Prince Turki Bin Talal Al Saud, governor of Aseer province, highlighted the success of the Ajaweed initiative, which mobilized 107,000 participants to foster social cohesion. "Aseer is not a tribal region—it's a collective of united people working for progress," he noted. Through initiatives like this, youth-driven community projects have reshaped Aseer's identity, proving that local engagement is vital for cultural transformation.

Reimagining Culture Through Storytelling

Reinterpret culture one story at a time, ensuring authenticity while adapting traditions into relatable timeless narratives that inspire intergenerational connections. Saudi author, screenwriter, and film director Maram Taibah emphasized storytelling's transformative power. She shared her approach of preserving Hejazi fairy tales from her grandmother stating, "To tell moving stories, you must absorb them first—whether from books, films, or the oral traditions of our ancestors." Baraa Alem, a Saudi actor, writer, and producer, echoed this sentiment, stressing the importance of authenticity: "Let's stop copying Western mythologies. We have our own rich cultural treasures waiting to be told." Their discussion highlighted storytelling's role in preserving and evolving cultural narratives.

Shaping the Future with Cultural Innovation

Infuse local heritage into anime, art, podcasts, and other creative outputs, to expand local cultures' global footprint and demonstrate how collaboration and innovation overcome challenges. Artist Mohammed Aldhafeeri from Manga Productions described how Future's Folktales blends Saudi heritage with innovative storytelling. "We don't just tell stories—we ensure each episode reflects Saudi culture authentically while meeting global standards," he said. On the other hand, Game Producer, Ohoud Alqahtani explained how the mobile game builds on this narrative, stating, "Our game transforms cultural stories into interactive experiences, making heritage accessible to a global audience." Such projects illustrate how cultural innovation expands Saudi Arabia's influence worldwide.

EDUCATION - BUILDING THE SKILLS FOR TOMORROW'S LEADERS

Integrating AI and Technology into Education

Embed AI into education to enhance personalized learning, as Dr. Thamer AI-Harbi, Executive Director of the National Center for Artificial Intelligence, emphasizes: "The future of education lies in leveraging AI to cater to individual learning needs." As education systems evolve, AI-driven tools will be increasingly employed for adaptive learning. This shift, according to Dr. Heidi Alaskary, Senior Director at Diriyah Company, and Hamad Alhussaini, ISEF Winner, requires equipping instructors with training in emerging technologies. Platforms like Scleral and DreamBox Learning already offer adaptive learning tools that help teachers tailor experiences to individual student needs. Additionally, public-private partnerships, such as the collaboration between Saudi Arabia's private sector and the Mawhiba Foundation to create AI-powered curricula for gifted students, highlight the transformative potential of technology in education.

Embedding Mental Fitness & Resilience in Education

Equip students with the mindset to view adversity as an opportunity for growth. Nuno Gonçalves Pedro, Managing Partner & Founder of Chameleon, emphasized, "If you're always processing rejection and adversity as positive catalysts, you'll do really well in life," highlighting resilience as key to success. To instill this mindset, resilience-building practices must be integrated into curricula, as seen in the Qassim Scientific Center's educational initiatives, which focus on critical thinking and perseverance. It is also important to encourage private-sector programs like Angela Duckworth's Character Lab in the U.S. and the MindUp program, created by the Goldie Hawn Foundation, fostering grit, emotional regulation, and stress management.

Bring Financial Literacy into Education

Embed financial literacy early on into curricula as exemplified by initiatives like: Thameen, a program designed to educate youth on investment planning, stock selection, and portfolio diversification, and Tadawul's experimental portfolios, which allow beginners to practice investing with virtual funds before transitioning to real investments. These initiatives equip youth with real-world investing tools, preparing them to leverage today's accessible financial markets. As H.E. Mr. Mohammad A. El-Kuwaiz, chairman of the Capital Market Authority, emphasized, "The Saudi market's liquidity and diverse opportunities create intersections for growth." His advice for the younger generation is to start early—an approach echoed by Eric Thomas, educator and New York Times bestselling author, in his book You Owe You.

Empowering Youth and Fostering their Participation through Education

Engage young people in decision-making, as Maha Alabduljabbar, Curator of WEF Riyadh Global Shapers Hub, emphasizes, "Over 60% of the Saudi population is under 30. It's time now that the youth are at the forefront of decision-making." This is exemplified by Human Capability Development Program (HCDP) programs allowing youth to engage in decision-making processes, such as advisory boards and mentorship initiatives, giving them a platform to become change agents. Furthermore, schools should integrate social impact by establishing youth-led projects or hackathons, where students create solutions for local challenges, building leadership and innovation. Additionally, Heidi Alaskary, CEO of Diriyah Company, highlights the importance of fostering intergenerational dialogue. To enable this, schools can facilitate mentorship programs, where older generations guide students on leadership, responsibility, and pressing issues.

Fostering Entrepreneurial Mindset through Education

Prioritize developing an entrepreneurial mindset by combining theory with practical application. For example, Mawhiba Foundation's five-step journey—exploration, empowerment, excellence, enablement, and engagement—has empowered over 215,000 young talents in Saudi Arabia through STEM competitions, skill development, and entrepreneurship guidance. It's also essential to foster a risk-taking environment. Hassan "AboFlah" Suleiman, a YouTuber and gamer, stresses, "Don't wait for ideal circumstances. Just take that first step." Educational strategies should incorporate this mindset by offering opportunities to start small businesses, engage in social enterprises, or experiment with new technologies, allowing students to learn from failure and refine ideas. Additionally, education should emphasize soft skills like emotional intelligence, communication, and empathy - key leadership traits identified by Yasir Khan, founder of SpeakLikeACEO.com.

WELLBEING – FOSTERING MIND-BODY WELLNESS

Encouraging Mind-Body Wellness Practices

Integrate holistic wellness approaches into daily routines that consider both the mind and body. Dr. Reham Garash discusses the importance of understanding the gut-brain connection and how emotions are physically stored in the body, while Diana Chao, Founder of Letters to Strangers, emphasizes that "staying connected to our bodies and our communities reduces the chances of falling into despair more effectively". Integrating holistic wellness practices such as mindfulness, yoga, and dietary habits into school curricula or workplace wellness programs can help individuals foster resilience. Encouraging employees and students to engage in wellness programs that balance mental, emotional, and physical health can improve productivity and overall well-being.

Utilizing Sports as a Tool for Resilience and Mental Growth

Encourage the use of sports to build resilience and mental wellness, as exemplified by mountaineer Farouq Al Zouman and football legends Sami Al Jaber and Majed Abdullah. They emphasize that success in sports requires discipline, perseverance, and mental strength—skills that are transferable to daily life. Schools and organizations should create opportunities for youth and adults to engage in sports, providing not only physical fitness but also a structured environment for promoting teamwork, goal setting, positive mindset and overcoming obstacles and building self-confidence. This can be done through a combination of: regular sports tournaments, fitness classes, workshops, seminars and mentorship programs. Through this, sports become a powerful vehicle for mental wellness and lifelong growth.

Leveraging High-Profile Sports Events to Foster Mental Wellness

Harness high-profile events like the World Cup in Saudi Arabia to raise awareness of mental wellness and resilience, underscoring the core role of sports in fostering these qualities. For example, host fan zones, community programs, and workshops focused on emotional resilience and mental fitness, with activities like mindfulness sessions, sports challenges, and talks by coaches, athletes, and mental health experts. These discussions can highlight the link between physical activity and emotional well-being, along with personal stories of overcoming adversity, emphasizing discipline and perseverance. It would also be instructive to showcase key moments from the tournament that highlight teamwork and resilience, such as comebacks or personal triumphs leading to collective success. Public campaigns and media coverage could feature athletes sharing their mental health journeys and offering tips on managing emotions, handling pressure, and staying focused under stress.

Integrating Digital Solutions for Mental Health Support

Leverage technology to reduce the stigma around mental health. Tools like apps for discreet support, such as Labayh, allow individuals to access care in private, reducing barriers. Encouraging the use of apps like these can provide immediate assistance and resources for emotional well-being, offering users the ability to track their mental health and connect with professionals. As Basim AlBeladi, Founder & CEO of Labayh, states, "Half of all mental health disorders start before we turn 15. We need assessment throughout the Kingdom using mobile app integrations, AI, and wearable tech." By integrating technology, mental health solutions become more accessible, private, and culturally sensitive, enabling the next generation to receive timely interventions.

Fostering Safe Spaces for Open Emotional Expression

Establish spaces where individuals can express their emotions without judgment. Dr. Reham Garash, CEO & Founder of the Holistic Wellness Academy, emphasizes, "Life makes us wear many masks. We all need a safe space to feel everything, process, and be ourselves—a space to rediscover who we really are." In schools, workplaces, and communities, it is necessary to provide spaces for self-discovery and open conversations about mental well-being. Integrating programs that prioritize emotional safety, like Letters to Strangers, where people share their mental health stories anonymously, will cultivate a culture of acceptance and vulnerability. This not only encourages personal growth but also strengthens community bonds.

SUSTAINABILITY – YOUTH SHAPING SUSTAINABLE FUTURES

Adopting Circular Economy to Drive Transformation

Drive sustainability by transforming waste into valuable resources, integrating traditional practices with modern innovation for practical, scalable solutions. Alex Mativo, CEO of Duck Analytics, shared his journey with the circular economy. For him, it is all about "turning e-waste into something beautiful." Louise Emmanuelle, Founder of The Cacao Project, advocated for blending ancestral knowledge with modern science: "Sometimes, looking into the future requires looking back into the past. The solutions to the world's problems already exist—we just need to unlock them." Moemen Sobh, CEO of Visenleer, added, "Waste is the gold of the 21st century. Start small: find waste, play with it, get creative, and you can save the environment." Local, practical actions like upcycling and innovative resource use have the power to drive the transition to a sustainable global economy.

Achieving Global Synergy for Sustainability

Attain global synergy for sustainability by fostering cross-sector collaboration and implementing science-driven solutions to address global challenges, particularly in food security and water scarcity. Laalitya Acharya, Founder of The Nereid Project, shared her personal connection to water scarcity: "Purpose, process, and policy are the three steps that create unique, actionable solutions." She emphasized the importance of collaboration between scientists, policymakers, and stakeholders, stating, "It's critical to engage with all parties to create solutions that are actionable and sustainable." Through her innovation—a device detecting microbial contamination in water—Acharya demonstrated how science-driven solutions can tackle global water challenges while addressing local needs.

Scaling Local Impact for Global Sustainability

Leverage local expertise to strengthen community-led initiatives, demonstrating how local sustainability actions can create a significant global impact. Mohammad Abunayyan, Chairman of ACWA Power, described the immense potential of youth in driving sustainability, declaring, "The youth are the true renewable energy of the nation. With opportunities in renewable energy, all your dreams can come true." He stressed the importance of resilience and adaptability, saying, "Flexibility and persistence are crucial. Don't be afraid to adjust your goals when facing obstacles." By empowering youth and leveraging local talent, Abunayyan illustrated how initiatives in renewable energy not only contribute to national goals but also create a ripple effect on global sustainability.

Empowering Communities Through Grassroots Action

Empower communities through grassroots action, engaging youth to lead collective environmental actions and inspire long-term stewardship for a sustainable future. Jimrey Buntas, Founder of The Filipinos for the Saudi Green Initiatives, posed a profound question during his '2,030 Steps to a Better World' session: "What would the world look like if everyone did just one thing to benefit the environment?" Reflecting on his initiative to mobilize communities, Buntas believes that the key to success is collaboration. "Find people who believe in your vision and take action," he pointed out. His grassroots efforts have inspired over 500 volunteers to participate in tree planting and waste reduction campaigns. By engaging youth and fostering community responsibility, Buntas demonstrated how collective action can build a sustainable future for all.

Integrating Sustainability into Business Action

Embed sustainability into business action through measurable steps like waste reduction, carbon emissions tracking, and renewable energy adoption, fostering transparency and building trust. Lara Hussein, Co-Founder of The Waste Lab, believes that "sustainability is not just about status; it is about regeneration and changing things fundamentally," while Reyhan Jamalova, Founder and CEO of Rainergy, reflected on her journey while illustrating how sustainability can transform underserved communities, stating. For her, "Sustainability has been central to our mission—providing clean, affordable energy paves the way for better health, economic growth, and inclusion." Alexander Olesen, CEO of Babylon Micro-Farms, reinforced that "being sustainable comes down to the core of what your business does—if it's improving efficiency and solving real problems, it's meaningful." The necessity of aligning sustainability with core business goals is growing more evident, along with the importance of setting measurable metrics like waste reduction and soil health to build trust and transparency.

Utilize technology and cultural understanding to bridge discrepancies and create meaningful collaborations. Engagement fosters mutual understanding, sparks innovation, and drives initiatives that address shared challenges, reinforcing the role of youth as catalysts for global progress. Rishab Kumar Jain, a researcher at Harvard Medical School emphasized, "Youth raised in a tech-first era are uniquely positioned to tackle tomorrow's problems." During one of his sessions, Hassan "AboFlah" Suleiman showcased how he leveraged digital platforms for large-scale campaigns, such as raising USD 11 million for education and clean water projects.

Driving Global Change with Youth-Led Innovation

Foster mentorship and share impactful stories, as they inspire others to act, demonstrating the transformative power of youth leadership in creating a more sustainable and equitable world. Founder of the Anupam Foundation Anoushka Sinha recounted how she started her journey with the Foundation at age 10, which later impacted over a million people. Similarly, Social Entrepreneur Liam McLeavey discussed how partnerships and persistence scaled his entrepreneurial efforts for sustainable development.

Shaping the World Through Passion and Purpose

Address critical issues such as social justice, environmental sustainability, and mental health. By drawing on heritage, collaboration, and innovative approaches, young leaders amplify minority voices, preserve traditions, and create lasting societal impacts. Jana Yamani's Project 1932 connects Saudi youth with leaders to foster change, while Nelly Attar's advocacy for sports as a tool for mental health illustrates passion-driven leadership. For Nelly, "Only those who risk going far can see how far they can go." Artist Noura Binsaidan utilizes her passion for art to preserve Saudi culture through public projects that blend tradition with innovation.

Leveraging Technology for Global Impact

Lead global philanthropic efforts and drive impactful change. From digital platforms to creative campaigns, young leaders harness innovation and resilience to inspire global communities, raise awareness, and deliver tangible solutions to pressing challenges. Researcher Areej Alqarni emphasized how tools like Al enhance research efficiency, allowing young scientists to achieve ambitious goals with precision, out of his belief that the ultimate

level of happiness is "making others happy," Hassan "AboFlah" Suleiman utilized livestreaming to raise USD 11 million in donations; presenting a true example of how social media can drive large-scale philanthropy. For HRH Princess Reema Bander Al Saud, digital tools empower youth to "think big and deliver global solutions."

Leading with Resilience in the Face of Adversity

Turn personal challenges into opportunities for growth and social change. By stepping out of their comfort zones and pursuing purpose-driven goals, youth inspire others to persevere in the face of adversity through hard work and vision, creating meaningful impact locally and globally. Portuguese Athlete and Social Entrepreneur Maria Conceição shared her journey from poverty to summiting Everest as an example of how resilience transforms adversity into opportunity. Her educational initiatives for underprivileged children also demonstrate how vision and determination inspire global change. For Maria, "The situation where you are now doesn't determine your future."

Shaping the Future of Global Events with Youth Leadership

Leverage global platforms, such as World Cup bids, for cultural exchange. Their involvement enhances professional growth and fosters innovation and cross-cultural understanding, positioning them as leaders who shape the future of such mega-events and the lasting legacies they create for future generations. Highlighting Saudi Arabia's leadership in esports through Abdulaziz Alshehri who shared his journey as the first Asian FIFA champion and his current efforts to organize tournaments.

Cultivating a Global Mindset for Collective Action

Transcend borders and promote inclusivity and collective action to address global challenges. By working together and leveraging diverse perspectives, young people are shattering barriers and creating unified movements that tackle pressing issues such as climate change, inequality, and social justice. During the 'Brushes with Progress' session, Nkuli Mlangeni-Berg, Founder & Creative Director of The Ninevites, highlighted her work in preserving African heritage through intergenerational programs, while Noura Binsaidan's art projects celebrated Saudi cultural identity on a global scale.

Adopting Digital Infrastructure as a Foundational Pillar for Innovation

Develop digital-first policies that integrate digital technologies into key sectors like healthcare, education, and government services as exemplified by Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030. Naif Sheshah, Deputy Governor for Strategy and Digitalization in Saudi Arabia, emphasized that "digital infrastructure has become the third essential utility for technological innovation and sectoral growth in Vision 2030." This underscores the need to invest in scalable digital infrastructure that supports emerging technologies like AI, IoT, and blockchain and ensures cross-sector interoperability. Countries like Estonia, India, and Singapore have set standards with their e-Government, Digital India, and Smart Nation initiatives respectively. The next step is to inspire countries still progressing and extend these digitization approaches beyond the public sector, fostering cross-sectoral connectivity and innovation across industries.

Building and Fostering a Youth-Led Innovation Ecosystem

Encourage youth-driven innovation through mentorship programs, incubators, and innovation hubs, like Misk City in Saudi Arabia serving as a hub for youth-led tech startups. Eng. Omar Najjar, Deputy CEO of Misk Foundation, highlighted that "youth are the key drivers of change and innovation." This is why it is important to expand new funding methods like crowdfunding, peer-to-peer lending, and angel investing to increase young innovators' access to capital and enable the next generation of leaders, ensuring the sustainability of innovation. The global rise of platforms like Y Combinator and Techstars — renowned startup accelerators — showcases how nurturing young talent leads to the creation of groundbreaking technologies. Today's youth are leading in areas like digital entrepreneurship, AI, FinTech, and clean tech, and now is the time to amplify these efforts by investing in youth-focused programs, policies, and networks to accelerate their impact in shaping the future.

Balancing Innovation and Ethics for Responsible AI Development

Harness AI to drive innovation while ensuring ethical standards and human oversight, as emphasized by Steve Wozniak, Co-Founder of Apple Computer, and Bill Gates, Chairman of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Notably, in healthcare, education, and agriculture, AI offers significant benefits, such as personalized treatments, tailored learning, and improved crop yield predictions, yet concerns like data privacy, algorithmic bias, and resource sustainability must be addressed through clear regulation. Governments and tech companies must collaborate to establish frameworks prioritizing human oversight and ethics. Global initiatives, like the EU's AI regulations and UNESCO's AI ethics guidelines, should serve as models for countries and companies, fostering a cohesive international approach.

Fostering Strategic Partnerships to Drive Innovation

Encourage governments, private companies, and research institutions to form strategic partnerships that drive innovation. For example, NASA's collaboration with SpaceX revolutionized space exploration. As Bill Gates emphasized, "Innovation accelerates when stakeholders from diverse sectors collaborate." This is especially true in the digital economy, where cross-industry partnerships are key to solving global challenges. Space technologies, for example, address issues in agriculture, resource management, and tourism. Governments should hence create public-private innovation hubs and offer targeted incentives such as funding, tax breaks, or policy reforms to promote partnerships in AI, space exploration, and digital infrastructure. These partnerships should be assessed by indicators like patents filed, tech jobs created, and improved service access.

Introduce lessons on responsible social media use, digital footprints, and online etiquette. Use platforms like Instagram or TikTok to demonstrate how actions online can impact future opportunities.

Simulate Digital Citizenship Scenarios:

Use role-playing or case studies to show how to handle situations like digital privacy issues, managing screen time, or protecting personal data, much like the initiatives in Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 educational programs.

Provide Real-World Tech Tools:

Integrate Al-based programs, like Al-powered learning apps, to help students develop technical skills alongside their digital literacy knowledge.

Introducing youth to modern funding methods like crowdfunding and peer-to-peer lending equips them with financial literacy to bring AI projects to life. Vision 2030's initiatives offer platforms for young innovators to scale their ideas.

- 2 Develop frameworks that prioritize inclusivity, equity, and access to opportunities for young people across sectors.
- Facilitate partnerships between youth and experienced professionals in fields such as AI, energy, and entrepreneurship to accelerate growth and innovation.
- Allocate funding and resources to youth-led initiatives addressing global challenges like climate change, water scarcity, and digital equity.
- Use AI, virtual simulations, and other digital tools to enhance learning experiences and prepare students for future technological advancements.
- Measure the success of youth-led initiatives through tangible outcomes, such as reduced carbon emissions or improved community engagement, and share these results to inspire further action.
